The Face of TSA

Security Support Assistants and Transportation Security Officers are the face of the agency, the people on the front lines and the most important roles at TSA. For many people, working in these roles has led to a long, fulfilling career with the federal government.



Step into the role quickly.

Security Support Assistant (SSA):

Working closely with their TSO counterparts, SSA duties include adherence to procedural safety regulations throughout the passenger screening process, basic data entry and report creation, communication with senior employees and additional security support as necessary.

Build the knowledge base to inform decisions at all levels.

Transportation Security Officer (TSO):

TSOs are responsible for providing security and protection of travelers across all transportation sectors in a courteous and professional manner. Duties may also extend to securing high-profile events, important figures and/or anything that includes or impacts our transportation systems.

Hiring Process

The hiring process varies by role and by candidate and is dependent upon each individual airport's hiring needs. Here's a general overview of the hiring process:

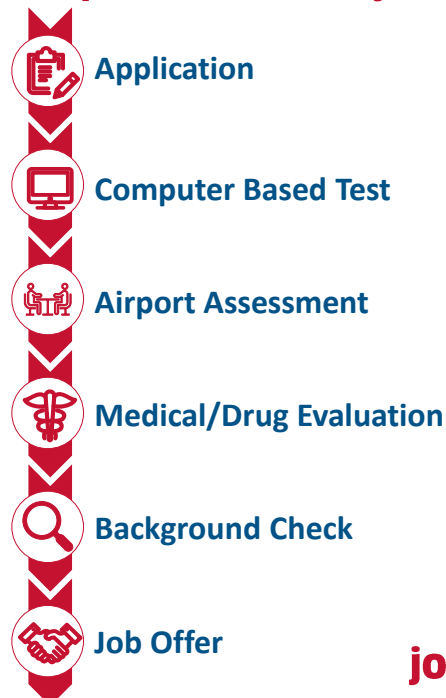
Security Support Assistant

Minimum Qualifications

- 18 years or older.
- U.S. citizen or national.
- High school diploma, GED or security experience equivalent.
- **No previous security experience is required.**

What Should I Expect?

This one-day event will feature multiple hiring components. Provided you pass each component, your day could consist of:

- Attending an information session to learn more about the TSO position and employment with TSA;
- Applying for the TSO position, if you did not apply online prior to the event;
- Taking a computer-based test (CBT) to evaluate English language proficiency and object recognition aptitude;
- Participating in a structured interview to assess qualifications for the position;
- Completing a medical evaluation, federal drug screening (see below) and pre-hire background investigation soon after the event.

Tips for the Event

- Apply online in advance for quicker processing. Please note that a resume and previous work experience are not required for your USAJOBS profile or the TSA application.
- **Please bring your smartphone and/or passwords to access your email and USAJOBS account.**
- Bring two forms of valid federal or state government-issued identification.*
- Consider arriving early to allow more time to complete all components.
- If you don't feel well, please do not attend.
- Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes will be available.
- Social distancing protocols will be required with six-foot space areas marked.

**Forms of Identification: Upon arrival to the facility, you will be required to present two forms of identification. At least one form of identification must bear both a photograph and a signature. You will not be admitted to the test without these two pieces of identification. Both forms of identification must be legible, unexpired and issued with your full legal name, which must match the name on your TSA job application.*

Please do not bring the following items to the event: firearms, knives or weapons of any kind. Possession of such items will result in dismissal from the facility.
