What do Behavioral Health Technicians do?

Behavioral Health Technicians (BHT) Care for individuals with mental or emotional conditions or disabilities. BHT's may also monitor patients' physical and emotional well-being. In addition, BHT's may participate in rehabilitation and treatment programs or help with personal hygiene.

Program Benefits

- Training is free for qualified individuals
- We provide support services like job readiness/job search help
- Participants are eligible to receive a stipend for completing the program and finding a job in the field.
- Training credits count towards further education at MassBay Community College

Who is eligible?

Participants must be unemployed or income eligible and seeking employment. Grants are awarded to those who agree to find training related employment upon course completion. No prior healthcare experience is necessary. Other eligibility guidelines apply. Call now to learn more.
